- Are you Aged 18-25?
- Do you have an Education, Health and Care (EHC) Plan?
- Are you an independent traveller or working towards this?
- No formal qualifications needed.

What is Project SEARCH Supported Internship?

- A 1 year programme running from September to July
- 5 days a week, Monday to Friday.
- The programme is designed to help you get a paid job.
- You will spend your day at Phoenix Community Housing.
- You will complete three work placements. Each placement lasts for 10 weeks.
- You will have coaching and support from the onsite college lecturer, job coach and department managers and mentors.



What will you get out of Project SEARCH Supported Internship?

- You will gain the skills, support and experience needed to get a paid job in a real work setting.
- The chance to take part in a variety of work placements.
- More independence, confidence and improved self-esteem.
